### Ballaghveny Landfill/Recycling Centre

Ballaghveny Landfill/Recycling Centre will be **closed** from **December 25th – 28th inclusive** and closed again on **Thursday 1st & 2nd of January**. It will be open on the **29th to the 31st of January**. Opening hours will revert to normal from **Saturday 3rd of January**. i.e. Tue – Fri 8.30a.m – 5.00p.m, Sat 8.30a.m – 4.00p.m.



### Nenagh Recycling Centre

Nenagh Recycling Centre will be **closed** from **December 24th – 26th inclusive**. It reopens on **Monday 29th to Wednesday 31st December, 8.30a.m to 4.30p.m (both days inclusive)**. The facility will be **closed** on **1st & 2nd of January**. It reopens again as normal on **Monday 5th January at 8.30a.m to 4.30p.m**.

The facility will be open on **Saturdays 10th, 17th & 24th of January** to assist householders with all of that extra recycling and to take Christmas Trees.



### Christmas Tree Recycling

From **January 10th to 24th inclusive**, Christmas Trees will be accepted free of charge at the Recycling Centre, Nenagh; Parnell Street Carpark, Thurles; Area Office, Roscrea; Town Park, Templemore.



### Recycling at Home

The following items can be recycled at home in your Recycling Bag or Blue / Red Bin: **Cardboard, Gift wrap, Greetings cards & envelopes, Paper packaging, Drink & Food cans, Biscuit Tins, Juice Cartons, Plastic Bottles (drinks/milk/detergent).**
