Taoiseach launches Business Guide to Wise Waste Management for Midlands Region

North Tipperary County Council in conjunction with the four other Midlands Local Authorities (Laois, Offaly, Westmeath and Longford) have produced a 'Business Guide to Wise Waste Management' which was launched recently by An Taoiseach, Brian Cowen. This business guide offers advice and information to businesses within the region on waste legislation, how to kick start waste management planning in your business & finally it offers general advice on waste by sector such as office waste, farm waste, retail waste and construction and demolition waste.

At the launch of the booklet, Áine Mc Carthy, Environmental Awareness Officer with North Tipperary County Council commented that "The booklet was designed collectively by the Environmental Awareness Officers in each County, as there was an obvious need to enhance and promote green business with the region. This guide offers advice on waste legislation which is applicable to business as well as identifying types of waste produced by different sectors and how to manage this waste in a more sustainable manner. It is quite concise but informative and it is hoped to support and follow this up with business seminars in the County at a later stage"
