North Tipperary County Council Sign €161,000 Contract

North Tipperary County Council signed a contract this week worth a minimum of €161,000 with Kilderry Instruments in respect of a Telemetry System for use at Ballaghveny Landfill.

Mr Terry O’Niadh, County Manager, stated that this contract will enable the highest possible standards of environmental monitoring and protection to be utilised at the landfill. This SCADA Telemetry system is a further example of North Tipperary County Council’s commitment to ensuring that the protection of our environment is not compromised.
